

## Curriculum Information - Year 7

### **Autumn term:**

Y7 begins with an introductory unit on what is history and explores some of the key concepts that underlie the study of history, which incorporates a local study focused on Frances Mary Buss. We then study the development of Church, state and society in Medieval Britain 1066-1509

Key enquiries include:

- What is Frances Mary Buss' legacy?
- Why did William win the battle of Hastings?
- How well did English medieval monarchs deal with the challenges they faced?
- Which was the greatest liberator for peasants in Medieval England - the Black Death, or the Peasants Revolt?

### **Spring term:** The wider medieval world

Key enquiries include:

- Who was Mansa Musa and what can his story tell us about Medieval Africa?
- What travelled on the Silk Roads?

### **Summer term:** Change in the medieval world

Key enquiries include:

- What was the most significant invention from the medieval Arab world?
- How did the renaissance change the world?
